This session will include a discussion of opioid/heroin addiction disease and management of acute overdose. Students will be placed into interprofessional teams following a classroom demonstration of naloxone. They will then work together in a simulated experience to treat a patient with acute overdose. Following the naloxone treatment simulation, they will move the hospital simulation suite and discuss post-acute hospital management.

Health care teams will consist of 3-5 members of the different health professions. The session will include a classroom presentation, simulation, debrief, and bedside presentation. Faculty facilitators from the various professions will circulate amongst teams during the simulation and debrief to provide guidance, structure, and input. There will be 6 teams working simultaneously and the sessions will repeat 3 times during the day.

Program Objectives

1. Discuss the roles of various healthcare professionals in the treatment of acute overdose of opioids/heroin. (IPEC competency: VE1)
2. Identify signs and symptoms of opioid/heroin overdose. (IPEC competency: VE1&5)
3. Demonstrate proper treatment of opioid/heroin overdose using naloxone. (TT4)
4. Describe post-acute management of a patient with opioid/heroin overdose. (TT4)
5. Discuss prevention strategies of opioid addiction for healthcare professionals. (TT4)

Event Details:

Participants should use the Wilbraham Rd entrance marked for Public Safety/Athletic fields. Follow event parking signs. Please carpool is possible. (Simulations check-in will be on the second floor - which is ground level from the front entrance). Certificate of attendance will be provided following the event and completion of evaluation tool.
