Summary: This activity will explore communication and team tools for effective interdisciplinary patient care.

Learning Objectives

This program is designed to teach core inter-professional competencies¹ that are necessary for collaborative practice. The skills learned are useful to understanding the need for practicing shared problem solving with interdisciplinary teams of care givers and its impact on safe and effective patient care.

1. Engage other health professionals—appropriate to a specific care situation—in shared patient-centered problem solving. (IPEC competency: TT3¹)
2. Explain the roles and responsibilities of other providers and how the team works together to provide care, promote health, and prevent disease. (IPEC competency: RR4¹)
3. Use unique and complementary abilities of all members of the team to optimize health and patient care. (IPEC competency: RR9¹)
4. Listen actively, and encourage ideas and opinions of other team members. (IPEC competency: CC4¹)
5. Reflect on individual and team performance for individual, as well as team, performance improvement. (IPEC competency: TT8¹)

Format: The session will include a Team STEPPS paper chain activity and review of communication tools and methods for effective team work. The students will also participate in a multidisciplinary escape room where they will incorporate problem solving, communication, situational awareness and shared decision-making to complete the activity. Following the simulation, students will regroup to debrief reviewing the IPE competencies, team performance and individual outcomes.
