**Summary:** This interprofessional simulation will offer students the experience of an ethics case consultation. Each student will be assigned a role representing patient, family, and healthcare professionals. A team facilitator will guide the process of ethical decision making. This is applicable to all levels of students and professionals in all healthcare professions.

**Program Objectives:**

1. Participants will receive an overview of some basic principles and theories of medical ethics. (IPEC competency: VE7,8,9 & TT2)
2. Participants will apply an ethical problem solving approach to a patient case. (IPEC competency: TT3)
3. Participants will participate investigating other health care provider roles and experience role playing in a team environment to establish a plan of care for the patient case. (IPEC competency: TT4)
4. Participants will discuss the benefits and difficulties of working as a team to see multiple views of a patient case. (IPEC competency: RR3)

**Format:** This session will include an introduction to ethical dilemma case discussion. Students will participate in a small-group (4-6), role-play activity, simulating an ethical case discussion. The session will end with a debriefing.
