SEMESTER 1

Core Competencies and Health Topics (6 credits).

January 2021 class held via Zoom. Class sections on Monday and Wednesday evenings or Saturdays.

6-8 hours per week for online assignments.

SEMESTER 2

Practicum Class for CHWs (3 credits).

Class will be held online.

Students must complete a 125-hour practicum placement at an assigned local service provider or health center (about 10 hrs/week).
