SESSION ONE: Spring 2022 (March 22, 2022 - May 11, 2022)

First Year Experience for Behavioral Health - The course will cover topics such as study skills, academic planning, communication skills, , locating campus resources, and how to advocate for oneself during advising or financial aid conversations.

1 credit

SESSION TWO: Summer 2022 (June 6, 2022 - August 11, 2022)

SWK-101 - Introduction To Social Work - This course will familiarize students with the various roles, functions, and tasks which social workers perform in a variety of settings and acquaint them with the primary skills and practices of generalist social work.

3 credits

SESSION THREE: (September 6, 2022 - December 22, 2022)

PHL-255 - Ethics In Social Work and Human Services - This course exposes students to major and influential ethical schools of thought, as well as to ethical standards, issues, and dilemmas associated with social work and other human services. Prerequisite: ENG-101)*

3 credits

SESSION FOUR: Spring 2023 TBD

SWK-201 - Addiction/Substance Abuse - This course will explore the etiology of addiction and substance abuse disorder with emphasis on societal views and stigma. Attention will be paid to an array of addictions and not solely on Alcohol and other Drugs, these include but are not limited to: gambling, food, sex, the internet and other compulsive behaviors. (Prerequisite: SWK-101 - INTRODUCTION TO SOCIAL WORK)

3 credits

Participants in this training program will earn a micro credential in Human Services/Social Work at Springfield Technical Community College. This micro-credential stacks into a certificate and associates degree in Human Services/Social Work at STCC. This training program covers 10 credit hours and does not cover the full certificate or degree program cost.
