

TRAINING ANNOUNCEMENT

Free Direct Care Associate Training May-June 2022

The MassHire Hampden County Workforce Board is offering free training to individuals pursuing a career in behavioral health. Participants will have the opportunity to obtain OSHA 10, BLS/CPR-AED, Medication Administration Program, AHA-First Aid and WorkKeys-Career Readiness certifications. Additional program elements include De-Escalation, Non Violent Crisis Intervention, Trauma Informed, Overdose Prevention & Education, Domestic Violence and Narcan trainings. Successful program graduates will have the opportunity to interview for job placement with select behavioral health employers. Holyoke Community College (HCC) will deliver this training program.

Participants must be unemployed or underemployed and have an interest in a behavioral health career. Requirements for program enrollment are detailed in the accompanying *Direct Care Associate Training Program Eligibility Checklist & Self-Attestation Form*. Hampden county residents meeting program requirements are eligible to apply.
