Wear your clinical uniforms or professional attire, name tags, badges, bring any items they would routinely use in a basic physical exam-BP cuffs, etc.

This simulation will include a healthcare team working together in an ambulatory care environment. Faculty facilitators from the professions included will help guide the students/residents through the simulation focusing on teamwork, roles and responsibilities, values, and interprofessional communication (IPEC Core Competencies).

Program Goals

- 1. Clarify the role of physician assistants, medicine, nursing, pharmacists, and occupational therapy on the healthcare team
- 2. Formulate the communication skills necessary for working together on a patient care team

Outcomes

- 1. Identify and resolve misconceptions about other health professions. (IPEC competency: RR1)
- 2. Collaboratively develop and implement a patient care plan. (IPEC competency: RR2&3)
- 3. Critique and analyze health care team interactions and communications for further improvement. (IPEC competency: CC1&7)

Format: Health care teams will consist of 5-6 members of the different health professions. The session will include a Pre-brief, Simulation, and Debrief. Faculty facilitators from the various professions will circulate amongst teams during the pre-brief, simulation, and debrief to provide guidance, structure, and input. There will be 5 teams working simultaneously and the sessions will repeat 4 times during the day.

Participants should use the Wilbraham Rd entrance marked for Public Safety/Athletic fields. Follow event parking signs. Please carpool is possible. (Simulations check-in will be on the second floor - which is ground level from the front entrance). Certificate of attendance will be provided following the event and completion of evaluation tool.
